NTCCC WELCOMES NEWEST MEMBER ASSOCIATION!!

Ottawa, Ontario- On Monday, June 20, 2011 representatives of the *National Trade Contractors Coalition of Canada (NTCCC) met in Mississauga, Ontario and discussed its future plans and priorities. In addition, the NTCCC welcomed its newest member-the **Canadian Institute of Steel Construction (CISC)**.

CISC is the national industry organization representing the structural steel, open web steal joist and steel platework fabricating industries. It's membership comprises Canadian steel fabricating firms, detailers, Canadian steel mills and Canadian steel service centers. With the addition of **CISC**, NTCCC membership now comprises ten (10) trade associations.

Among other issues addressed on June 20, NTCCC discussed its main priorities specifically: **Prompt Payment and Promotion of Standard Industry Documents**.

With respect to the first priority, prompt payment, draft legislation was recently introduced in the Ontario legislature through a Private Members Bill 211 just prior to the summer recess. NTCCC plans to continue working on prompt payment legislation in Ontario (and other jurisdictions) and expects legislation to be reintroduced after the Ontario Fall election. On the Federal scene, NTCCC will continue to press the Federal Government for prompt payment provisions through regulatory change.

On the second priority, promotion of standard documents, NTCCC will be soon offering webinars on its (newly revised) Guide to the CCA Subcontract thereby reaching a broader audience.
